

DIGITAL PORTFOLIO SITE MAP

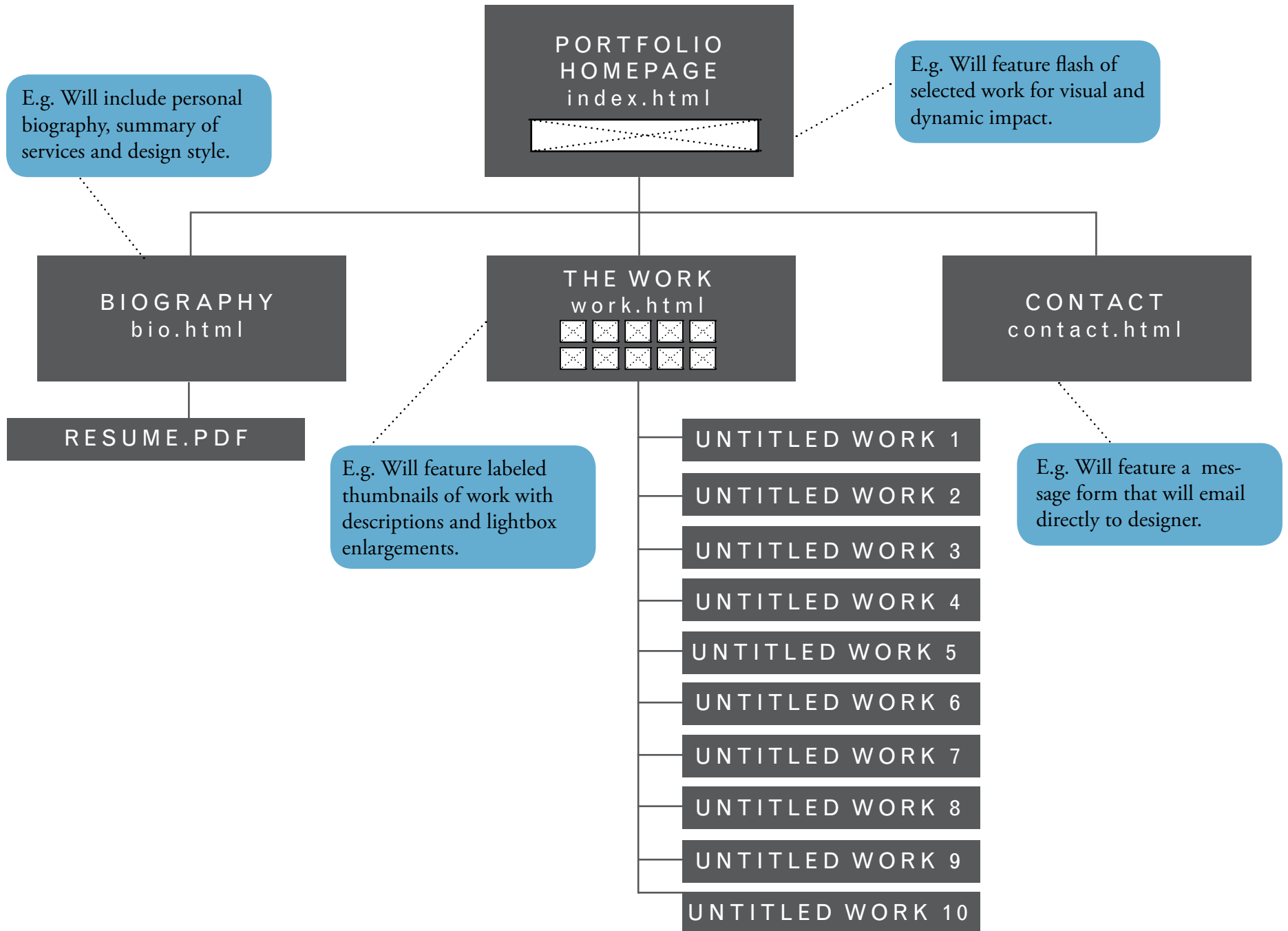
A site map is a representation of the architecture of a web site. In this case, it will take the form of a chart within a document, and will be used as a planning tool for your portfolio site. The site map will list the pages within your web site, will be organized in a hierarchical fashion and annotated to express functions & features as necessary.

Content and Organization



HOMWORK DUE THURSDAY.

Digital Portfolio must include & organize the following:

- Determine Medium (i.e. Flash, HTML/CSS)
- Biography/Profile Information
- Full Contact Information
(full address, telephone number, e-mail, URL) **Exceptions
- Provide Link to Resume PDF. **Exceptions
- Must state the file name of each page
- Annotate features and functions, as necessary
- Display 10-20 pieces of work (max)
- Account for inclusion of work labels and descriptions
- If work is subcategorized, include name of categories in site map, the name of the works and the order in which they will be organized via the visual site map.

Technical Specifications

InDesign or Illustrator

Fit within one standard page (8.5"x11" or 11"x17"), adjust your document size and orientation accordingly.

Save original, email a web PDF by the due date/time.
